8.	<p>SPENDING OF FUNDS It was agreed to fund Rebekah Cordery's request for seating in the new environmental area, similar to that in The Bramley Garden. This will enable the area to be used as a functional outdoor classroom and will cost approximately £3,000.</p> <p>BSA are looking for a large project to aim for, so that parents can see something specific that funds are being raised for. This could be something that takes 3 years to achieve. Suggestions include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outdoor play equipment, with prices starting at £4,000. This can be bought in many different forms and added to at later dates. • An energy efficient means of power generation, although this may cause problems with the County. • Assault Course equipment. • Shade for KS1 play area. <p>Contact County and see what process would need to be followed for looking at power generation.
