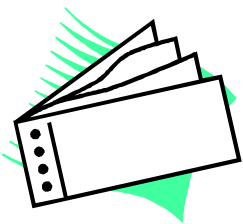
After all the snow and freezing temperatures, it has been wonderful to see the children enjoying the warm sunshine. Let's hope this isn't summer!

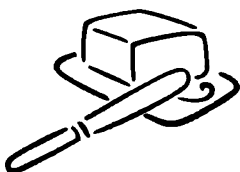

VOUCHER COLLECTIONS

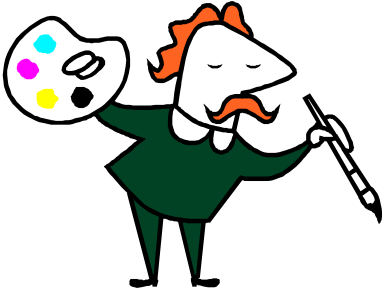


The Tesco and Sainsbury Voucher collections are well on their way. We are grateful for all donations from families.

We have been registered again by the Flora Cookery point system. We are given points towards buying items for Food Technology.



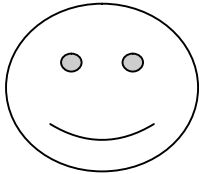
The Bramley Clift Surgery has asked for paintings and drawings from our school.
